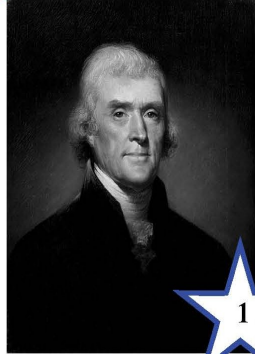

ROSA PARKS

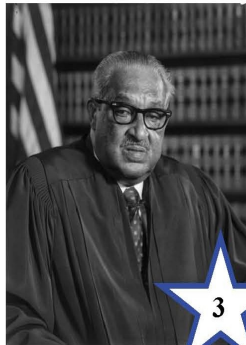


He was a Mexican American farm worker from Arizona. He fought to improve conditions for farm workers.



LAWYER

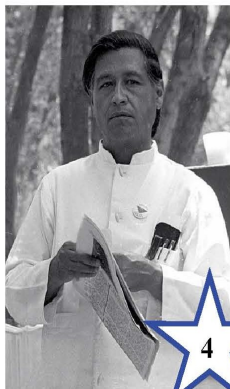
THURGOOD MARSHALL
